### **Horseshow Drug Tester**

The California Department of Food and Agriculture's Equine Medication Monitoring Program (EMMP) is seeking applications for drug testers.

This temporary seasonal position, classified as an Agricultural Aide, involves the collection of urine samples at horse shows for drug analysis, assisting veterinarians with the collection of blood samples, completing paperwork, and shipping samples to the labs. Current salary is \$10.87 per hour with applicable reimbursement for mileage.

Applicants to be considered must possess or demonstrate:

- 1) A strong background in equine husbandry
- 2) Basic computer skills
- 3) Excellent writing and speaking skills
- 4) Outstanding public relations skills
- 5) A valid driver's license and access to reliable transportation to and from horse shows in the area
- 6) Excellent physical fitness and agility to ensure the minimal risk of injury while working around horses, especially in enclosed stalls
- 7) The desire and ability to work variable and irregular hours related to horse shows, mostly weekends, and including holidays
