2b. Beginner Novice Indoor Eventing 2'6" - 2'9" @ 325 meters/minute	Show jumps with up to 3 cross-country portable fences that may include a log, ditch, bank, and/or brush fence
3a. Equestrian Habits Novice Table IIb 2'9 - 2'11"	Show jumps only
3b. Copper Meadows Novice Indoor Eventing 2'9" - 2'11" @ 350 meters/minute	Show jumps with up to 4 cross-country portable fences that may include a log, ditch, bank, and/or brush fence

4b. Training Indoor Eventing 2'11" - 3'3" @ 375 meters/minute	Show jumps with up to 5 cross-country portable fences that may include a log, ditch, bank, and/or brush fence
5a. Preliminary Table IIb 3'3" - 3'6"	Show jumps only
5b. Preliminary Indoor Eventing 3'3" - 3'6" @ 400 meters/minute	Show jumps with up to 6 cross-country portable fences that may include a log, ditch, bank, and/or brush fence
6a. Intermediate Table IIb 3'7" - 3'11"	Show jumps only
6b. Intermediate Indoor Eventing 3'7" - 3'11" @ 400 meters/minute	Show jumps with up to 7 cross-country portable fences that may include a log, ditch, bank, bounce, and/or keyhole
7a. Advanced Table IIb 3'11" - 4'3"	Show jumps only
7b. Advanced Indoor Eventing 3'11" - 4'3" @ 400 meters/minute	Show jumps with up to 3 cross-country portable fences that may include a log, ditch, bank, bounce, and/or keyhole

Pacific Indoor Eventing Series Rules

PIES will follow the USEA/USEF Jumping phase rules, USEF rules for cross-country dress and tack will be followed. All riders must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmet, protective vests (available for rent or purchase in the show office and at Equestrian Habits), and a medical armband (available for purchase at the show office and Equestrian Habits). Competitors may enter more than one level. Coaching is permitted.

There will be an audible signal to start. Circles on course will be scored as refusals, except at the Introductory level: you may circle in the open to slow but not once you have approached a fence. Fall of horse during jumping phase is immediate elimination and you must leave the course. Fall of rider while jumping is elimination and you must leave the course.

- Knock down: 4 points
- 1st refusal: 4 point
- 2nd refusal at same fence: 8 points
- 3rd refusal a same fence: Elimination
- Fall of horse and/or competitor: Elimination
- 4 refusals whole course: Elimination
- Exceeding optimum time: 1 point per second over
- Exceeding time limit: Elimination
- Leaving course (arena): Elimination
- Jumping incorrect jump, or jumping obstacles out of order: Elimination

Scoring: Penalties in the jumping are added to determine placing for each class. Closest to optimum time and lowest score wins. Ties will be awarded to the competitor with the closer to optimum time.
